Kuhn Group focuses on photovoltaics and sustainable energy

Salzburg AG is a reliable partner for the domestic company

In 2020, Salzburg AG installed a 19 kWp system on the roof of its headquarters in Eugendorf. This has now been expanded again in collaboration with Salzburg AG by 163 kWp. In future, 395 PV panels will generate more than 170,000 kWh of electricity per year, most of which will be consumed by the company itself.

"Climate and environmental protection is a central, strategic component of the Kuhn Group. It was therefore immediately clear to us that we would gradually equip all of our locations with PV systems. We started in 2020 with our headquarters in Eugendorf. Today, I am pleased to say that almost all of our Austrian locations now PV electricity," says Managing Director Stefan Kuhn explaining his company's strategy. Salzburg AG also equipped the German sites in Hohenlinden near Munich and Wisent near Regensburg with PV modules in 2022. "In order to be able to generate even more electricity from solar power at the Eugendorf site, we decided to expand the plant together with Salzburg AG. We use most of the electricity generated there ourselves," continues Stefan Kuhn.

Salzburg AG as a strong partner for the regional economy

"We want to double our own renewable electricity generation in the coming years and are setting the pace in the energy transition. This is also what we have set out in our strategic ambitions," explains Michael Baminger, CEO of Salzburg AG, and continues: "Supporting local companies like Kuhn in expanding their PV infrastructure is therefore very important to us. Like these companies, we are rooted in the region and can only drive change in Salzburg and beyond by working together. Formulating a strategy alone is not enough, implementation is what counts."

Kuhn is convinced of solar power

The climate-conscious and sustainable Kuhn Group also relies on green energy from solar power beyond the borders of Salzburg. Emco Hallein (a subsidiary of the Kuhn Group) also already produces 400 kWp on its own roof. At the Himberg site in Lower Austria, Kuhn realized a 119 kWp PV system in cooperation with Salzburg AG. Salzburg AG has also implemented systems with a total output of around 420 kWp for the company at sites in Germany, Upper Austria, Styria and Tyrol.

"Sustainability is very important to us as a family business with a long-term focus. Photovoltaics is an important component that not only saves CO₂, but also economic sense for us. Especially when you work with competent partners like Salzburg AG," Stefan Kuhn with satisfaction.
